#### Lift out briefing 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> November

There will be a briefing for those whose boats are lifting on both days at 2pm in the West Wing – you must attend one of these or make arrangements with Roy Turner to be briefed before lift or your boat will not be lifted.

## Working Weekend 3<sup>rd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> November
